- 1. Fireflies are not flies; they are actually beetles.
- 2. Fireflies have six legs.
- 3. The light fireflies emit comes from their belly, not their face, wings or tail.
- 4. Fireflies use their light to communicate with other fireflies and to scare away predators.
- 5. Fireflies can adjust their light so that they have different flicker patterns. And, different kinds of fireflies have different light signals.
- 6. The light fireflies produce is the result of a chemical reaction inside the firefly between oxygen and luciferase and luciferin. An energy-carrying molecule called ATP enables this process.
- 7. The firefly light is 10 times more energy efficient than a light bulb and does not produce heat (like a light bulb).
- 8. Firefly light can be yellow, green or orange.
- 9. Fireflies exist all over the world except Antarctica.
